A Report on

One day collaborative workshop Accreditation and Academic Excellence on 21st July 2023

This one day collaborative workshop is organized by the IQAC teams of Vellore Institute of Technology (both Vellore and Chennai campuses) and Anna University, Chennai. The motive of the workshop is to create an awareness among the affiliated institutions about the revised NAAC framework. The brochure was circulated to all the Engineering and non-Engineering institutions as well.

The workshop was inaugurated on 21st July 2023 at 9.30 am at AB2, Smart Classroom located at VIT, Chennai. Dr. S. Hemamalini welcomed the august gathering with a welcome note. Dr. A. Suresh Babu, Deputy Director-IQAC, Anna University briefed about the workshop. Dr. R. Gunasekaran, Director – IQAC, Anna University gave the felicitation address. ProVC of VIT Chennai, Dr. V. S. Kanchana Bhaaskaran, joined Dr. Hemamalini in welcoming the gathering and presented a detailed presentation about the different campuses, VIT's journey of academic excellence, programmes offered, research centres, ranking and accreditation credentials of VIT. Distinguished Professor and Advisor to Chancellor, Dr. S. P. Thyagarajan, gave the inaugural address. He insisted on the significance of quality in every act of HEIs. The integration of quality policy as per NEP-2020 illustrated the holistic development of HEIs.

Dr. R. Gunasekaran, Director- IQAC, Anna University, Chennai, started the workshop session on "Best Practices of NAAC A⁺⁺ Institutions". He reinstated the institutions' accreditation and rankings by throwing light on various national and international ranking and accreditation agencies. The basic practices of the best institutions were listed like pure drinking water, clean toilets, food availability during working hours, etc. and said that practicing the same would indicate quality culture and best practices of the institutions. He also insisted that time lining all the activities, effective planning, and ecosystem to build confidence would portray a good culture on par with global institutions. He also suggested a few best practices to be followed for every NAAC criterion. Sustainable development goals are of prime importance for holistic development across the globe. The activities in HEIs are to be aligned with such SDGs for the growth of institutions.

After the tea break, Dr. P. Kuppan, Director-DQAA of VIT Vellore, explained in detail the procedures to apply for NAAC, starting from submission of Institutional Information for Quality Assessment (IIQA). During his presentation, he shared the experiences VIT had while applying for 4th cycle of NAAC accreditation. Followed by the procedures and processes, he explained the weightages for all the key indicators and respective metrics of criteria 1, 2 & 3, standard operating procedures (SOP), benchmarks and formula to calculate the benchmarks of all quantitative metrics. Also the nuances to be followed in qualitative metrics were also shared with the participants.

After the lunch break, Dr. K. Chitra, Deputy Director – DQAA of VIT Chennai continued the NAAC revised framework for criteria 4 & 5 and explained the quantitative and qualitative metrics. Dr. S. Renuga Devi, Deputy Director – DQAA of VIT Vellore illustrated the qualitative and quantitative metrics of Criterion 6 in NAAC revised framework. All the critical points to be considered while presenting the self-study report (SSR) were shared with the participants. Student satisfaction survey (SSS) is one of the important score points in NAAC, and hence the significance and procedures to score the maximum point was explained by her. The impact of Effective documentation in preparation of SSR was insisted by her. The list of documents to be uploaded like approval of UGC/MHRD/state government for establishment of HEI, AQARs, etc. was explained. The different types of various documents, including policy documents were listed and briefed. Important suggestions were provided towards the preparation of NAAC revised accreditation framework. The concept of the optional metrics was also explained by her which would greatly help them in scoring well in NAAC.

An interactive session chaired by Dr. S. P. Thyagarajan was organized with the participants. ProVC, Dr. V S Kanchana Bhaaskaran joined him during the session. The participants were curious to understand certain critical points in the preparation of SSR. The chair of the session gave useful suggestions for their questions. During the valedictory session, ProVC distributed the certificate to the enthusiastic participants. Dr. David Maxim Gururaj, Assistant Director – DQAA, VIT Chennai concluded the workshop with her Vote of Thanks.




